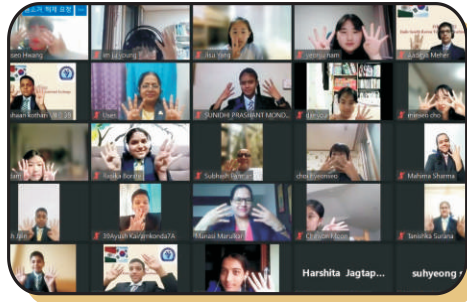

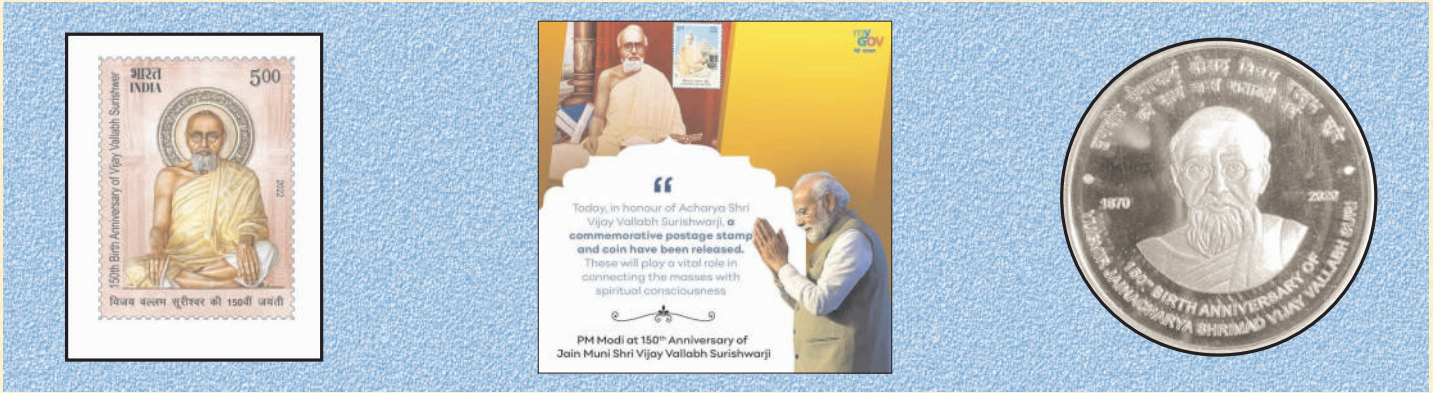

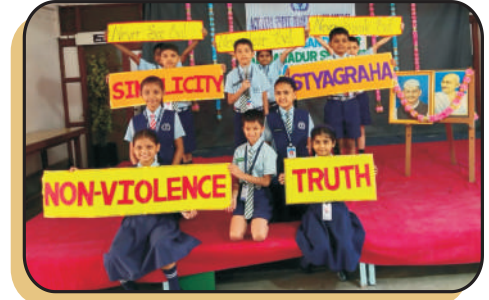

## Tips and Guidance to our young participants of Compuskills



**Rule 1:** ENJOY the experience : I wish to tell all my participants to first learn to enjoy the journey of compuskills competition. Yes, the format is of competition, but we judges call it a Festival of Creativity. So forget all the worries and threats about the competition and see it as Compuskills Festival.

**Rule 2:** Understand what is the topic and purpose : Many a times, we do not understand the true meaning of the topic. If you are not clear, take help of elders. Once you understand the purpose and meaning of the topic you will be able to better express your ideas.

**Rule 3:** Rules are important : The framework and method of evaluation is important to understand. Creativity, Concept, Animation , Technical skills showcased , images used, Audio used everything matters. More you create by your self instead of using readymade, the better. Use every possible feature of the tool which is applicable to your project.

**Rule 4:** Viva Rounds : When you come for viva round, just be clear that no one is taking your exam. You have done your project yourself and understand it the best. You just have to present it , explain the thought process behind it and answer the technical questions which you are already aware about like how you achieved a particular action.

**Rule 5:** Conduct Research : Every topic has enough material either online or in your text book. Before you start designing your project, make sure you are conducting enough research about the topic. In the final round judges may ask you questions which are related to your topic . Every Participant is winner for us and you are all very special for submitting your projects for us to evaluate. All the Best!

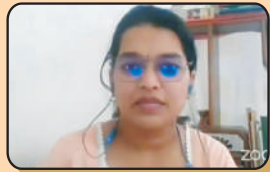

### Glimpses of Vijay Vallabh Sunday Hour

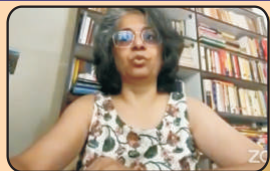
